Not Dead Yet.

It's been said that an organization is either growing or dying. You must have new members and people that will contribute their time and talents, or your organization will cease to exist. Churches are no exception to that rule. Members get older, move away, or eventually pass on and if there are not people to fill their shoes, the church will cease to exist.

The good news is that we at Plains are not dead yet. Yet our membership numbers seem to go down every year. We have been pretty good at adding some new members, but people of course leave and we are back to where we started, or sometimes worse.

The other good news is that we don't have to accept this lot in life. Look at the example Jesus gave us. He started small. Imagine – he didn't have the internet! No viral videos, no email blasts, no TV advertisements, and yet, he was able to generate massive interest, and generate the worldwide Christian Church that exists today with over 2 billion believers.

At the risk of boring you, I want to share two quick examples from my life as a member of the Cranberry Township Area Lions. In our District we have 37 clubs. I want to talk about two of them. The first is the New Castle Lions Club. They celebrated their one-hundred-year anniversary in 2023. It was a big shindig. Lots of local dignitaries – newspaper stories, pictures, the works. Today, that club is gone. One year later. Dead. Gone.

Another local club, Rochester – Beaver was small and dying. I think they had about 15 members. It sure looked like they were at the end of the line. Then they got one member. Her name is Rita. I know it isn't polite to talk about a woman's age, but she is a little older than me. Rita started to ask people to join and get involved with Lions. She was successful and she has sponsored at least 38 members. 38 new people – and some of these 38 have sponsored other new members. It grows like a chain letter. The club now has 82 members and is the largest in our District. I asked Rita what's her secret for growing her club so well, and she said, you just have to ask people and try to get them involved.

The moral of the story is that we just have to ask. Lots will say no. So, what. Some will say yes. When they say yes and come to church, we all need to get that person involved. Make them feel welcome and wanted. Invite them to events, make sure they know the love of Jesus Christ. And maybe, just maybe, one of the ones that says yes will be another Rita.




