It's not "Stewardship" month again already, is it?

Most of you know that as a church, we have a Stewardship "season". It's usually in the Fall and typically someone gives one or more "minutes for mission" type of speeches and there is usually an envelope and a pledge card in the mail.

This article isn't about that.

This article wants to make the suggestion to you that every month, indeed every week and every day is Stewardship Day.

God has given each of us everything we have. Our homes, our food and clothing, our possessions, indeed our very lives. God has given us each other – if you have a spouse, or children, or neighbors, or friends, or aunts and uncles. God has given us each other to help us with the day-to-day journey of life.

I think we need to sit back, reflect on our lives, pray, and consider what do I do today to make me a good steward of what God has given me?

Maybe you make a donation to someone or a cause or our church – maybe you give time to an organization – or to help a friend or neighbor. Maybe you make soup and give some to a person recovering from an illness, maybe you smile at a clerk in a checkout line. Whatever it is that you do, you are using what God has first given to you.

I would like to emphasize again that stewardship isn't necessarily about money. It's about our time and our talents. Giving a portion of what we have back for God's use.

Warren Buffet was once asked about his most valuable thing and he replied, it's his time. He has everything he wants or needs physically. There is no home, car, clothing, or food, that he cannot buy. But he cannot buy more time. God has given to each of us exactly the same number of hours in a day.

How will you use the hours that God has given to you today? Will you be a good steward and look for ways to give a portion of what God has given to you back to God each and every day?
