MINI-SERIES

The foundation of our faith as Christians is the forgiveness of sins through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Throughout Lent and culminating with Easter, we recognize the sacrifice Jesus made on our behalf. But these, and many other supernatural events and miracles found in the Bible are often challenged by critics of Christianity and non-believers (or as I like to refer to them, non-understanders).

Over the next three weeks, I have planned a "mini-series" of messages on Sunday mornings to address these challenges. Next week, March 20, we will begin this series with a discussion on the justification of belief. We will look at the evidence that supports our belief in the supernatural events and miracles in the Bible concentrating on Jesus' death, resurrection and appearance to the disciples. On week two, March 27, we will take the leap from belief to faith. How do we transition from belief to faith? Finally on week three, April 3, we will look at how sharing our faith with others can help them find Jesus. What does being a disciple of Jesus Christ mean?

With this information in out arsenal, we will be ready to respond to those who ask the question "Why should I believe?". By sharing our Christian faith with them, they too can become believers in Christ.
