Session met on Monday, December 13, 2021. Below are some of the highlights of that meeting.

Approved the Session Meeting minutes from October 18, 2021, and the Congregational Meeting part I minutes November 28, 2021, by consensuses.

CNS Parties are planned. Things are going well. Christmas luncheon was held. Church members are reading to the children.

Session reviewed the financial reports of the church. Giving is a little ahead of last year and expenses are better this month, but a little more than the budget. Frank reviewed the budget for next year and we will be voting on it at the January Session meeting.

Amy Roscoe has been elected moderator of the Deacons. Julie Raatz talked about the role of Deacons at Plains and all the good things they are doing.

The Youth Group Spaghetti Lunch fundraiser was on December 5, 2021. \$420 was raised. Looking forward to starting adult Sunday school in the new year.

The craft fair was well attended, and people are looking forward to next year.

Manse is ready to rent. Prospective renters are looking at it. The rent will be \$1,300 per month plus utilities.

Communion for 2022 will be held on April 17, June 5, October 2, and December 4 for 2022. Motion from committee. Approved by Session by consensus.
