Session Highlights April 2022

Session met on Monday, April 11, 2022. Below are some of the highlights of that meeting.

CNS Open House was a great success. School year is wrapping up and all is well.

Session reviewed the financial reports of the church. Frank Aloi also reviewed our investments, and the first quarter was down across the board.

Approved moving the Leopold Trust funds to a Charles Schwab Account.

Deacons have set a date set for Strawberry Festival. Hygiene kits will be assembled at the Strawberry Festival.

Seven youth attended the lock-in Friday, March 18, 2022. Everyone had a good time.

"Paying it Forward" idea was briefly discussed.

Women's night out was very successful with 14 women attending.

Tom Lunney reported that he will be meeting with the Township on April 22nd to discuss waivers for the pavilion.

On April 30 Ben Delligatti will be working to clean the tombstones.

First Sunday in June, we will have a cake for Pentecost. Worship committee will have a meeting to discuss who will be filling the pulpit on Sundays when Pastor Michael won't be able to attend.

Contract for Pastor Michael Burkley was presented and Session approved it.

Contract for Pastor Bob Goossen is slightly different in that we will be paying 10% of his salary directly to his church. Session also approved this contract.

Rev. Dr. Peter shared an email from Pastor Bob about what will be needed as a Transitional Team. A short discussion of possible people to serve on the Transition Team was held.

Next Regular Session Meeting will be on Monday, May 9, 2022 at 7:00 pm with Rev. Michael Burkley moderating.
